Grant applications are accepted throughout the year and awarded based on availability of funds.

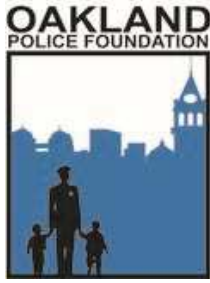
To be considered, please submit a completed Grant Application approved by your chain of command and attach any material or additional information that will support your request to:

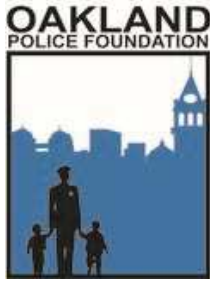
